How long does a car battery last if left unused?

If you know your car battery is relatively new and has been kept in good condition, it can probably sit unused for about two weeks before it goes flat, however in other cases a car battery can last between two weeks to four months. If you've left your car unused for over two weeks, it's quite likely you'll need professional assistance.

How long can a car battery sit on the shelf?

A brand new battery can sit on the shelf for two years, but if the charge falls too low, it will be permanently damaged. What happens if you don't start your car for a week? If your battery is in excellent condition, then nothing will happen over a week. With a weak battery, you may find the car won't start.

Can a car battery die if unused?

Yes, it can. Batteries discharge over time when not in use. So, if a car sits unused for too long, it can kill the battery. This is especially true for older batteries, around three or more years old. What can prevent a battery from dying when unused? To prevent a battery from dying when unused, follow these tips:

Should you disconnect a car battery if you leave it unused?

The answer is simple. If you plan to leave your car unused for extended periods of time, it's smart to disconnect the battery. This can prevent the battery from draining. Not being used for 20 to 60 days is going to make it go flat. Before disconnecting the battery, make sure you understand the necessary steps. Here's how:

Do all batteries lose their charge while sitting unused?

All batteries lose their charge while sitting unused. That applies to car batteries, your cell phone battery, AAA batteries for your flashlight, or the gel cell battery in your electric start lawn mower. How much the battery self-discharges depends on the type of chemistry used and the storage conditions.

How long will a car battery hold a charge?

How long a battery will hold a charge depends on its age condition. A brand new, fully charged battery will last two months or more. That said, it's not a good idea to leave them this long. An older, weak condition battery will lose its charge much more quickly. If your car has an alarm system, the battery will go flat more quickly.

I have a 1000D and from experience I can tell that after 3 months of not using the camera and the battery left inside, the battery monitoring circuitry still runs as long as the battery is inside. And that burns some charge. If you shoot at least once a week, leave the battery inside, if it's more than a month. Make sure it stays outside.

Some chargers can fully charge a battery in just a few hours, while others may take up to 24 hours. It's recommended to consult the user manual for your charger to ...
