A minimum order is the smallest amount of items a business agrees to sell to a customer. Businesses willing to sell customers a single item at a time would have a minimum order of one. Other businesses will only allow customers to purchase in larger quantities, and therefore have higher minimum orders. How do you find the minimum order quantity?
