

Can old mobile phone batteries be reused?

Old mobile phone batteries can be reused in various projects. I have been using used batteries in my projects after discovering a module on eBay. The module comes with a Li-ion charger and a voltage regulator, enabling the increase of the Li-ion battery's voltage from the standard 3.7V's to up to 30V's.

Should you recycle old batteries?

Old batteries pose a significant threat to our surroundings when disposed incorrectly - but you don't have to dispose or recycle old or dead batteries! If you've been keeping old batteries and you don't want to trash them, you will be happy to know you can turn them into the next exciting and useful DIY project.
