

Lithium battery recycling workshop explodes

What happened to the electric car battery recycling plant?

The industrial-scale electric car battery recycling plant suffered another fire on 5 July, 2023, just one day after the £10m facility opened. Six fire engines and an aerial platform are currently at the scene on Lincoln Street. There were no reports of any injuries.

Can lithium ion batteries explode?

Lithium-ion batteries can explode if damaged or crushed. The Environmental Services Association says resulting fires cost fire services and waste operators some £158m a year. Non-profit organisation Material Focus, which surveyed local authorities, runs an online search tool to help people find their nearest recycling point.

Are lithium-ion batteries a fire risk?

Lithium-ion batteries present a fire risk when over-charged, submerged in water, or damaged. Using faulty or poorly manufactured devices and chargers further increases the risk. A battery recycling plant owned by LiBatt Recycling erupted in a fire on Tuesday (January 2nd) after several 'minor explosions' were heard.
