

Hi I just bought my 13 PM (used) with 99% battery health. All is well with the device: no white/green screen update issue, no "un-genuine" parts, and has true blacks with OLED and true tone. However, when in some positions usually holding the phone horizontally to vertically, I feel something loose inside and I think it's the battery.

Battery Stuck Hello team please assist my battery for iPhone X is stuck @ 82% whether it's turning on or being used frequently it just remains and 82% until it switches off...The battery health is showing 100% and when charged for a proper time the battery will last like the health is still good but just won't move the percentage

So I salvaged a battery from a car, I have no idea how old it is, and it's about 0,6 volts but never mind that. When I spin it I can hear the acid moving around more than I suspect is normal. Thing is, I don't normally go around shaking or twirling car batteries for obvious reasons, nor do I pay much attention to the sound of them when handling.

I'm brand new to iPhones - just got a 13 Pro - and occasionally, when I tilt the iPhone, I feel/sense a strange movement of something weighted that is "slipping around" inside ...

When you shake your car battery, it recharges your car's battery and helps to connect the system by providing power. Then you shake your car's battery. The electrolytes are shaken inside the cells and are mixed well in the electrolytic ...

Now I'm wondering, I also installed a new nvme and the cmos battery is directly under it, will there be any problem if the cmos battery gets unstuck again and touches the nvme? I know that the nvme can get up to 50C in temps, so I'm ...

Don't twirl or shake a battery because the top may be removable to add water and you could spill it/ if it flies out of your hand it could hurt someone or be damaged.

The battery got loose inside of it, and now it doesn't work unless I keep pushing the batteries in (so it is useless because I have to take the back off and leave it off and do this with each click). This happened with my previous logitech mouse as well.

If you hear a sound like water sloshing around inside your car battery, then it could be due to one of two possible reasons. Firstly, if there's water inside the battery, it could ...

Probably a fake Chinese lithium-ion cell. It probably has a AAA battery inside (so it has some voltage), or perhaps not even that. The rest is likely sand. The sound you're hearing is probably the sand, or whatever garbage they stuck inside to ...
