

## **The power cord light does not light up after the battery is unplugged**

What happens when the battery is unplugged?

When unplugged the circuit breaks and is only going thru the few cells that the battery has left to run on. The battery is made up of so many cells and it needs those at full power to display the screen brighter and different things like that. The cells drain over time and deplete the power source.

How to prevent power cord from being unplugged?

To prevent a power cord from being unplugged, ensure that the cord is plugged in properly and that the power outlet is working well. If not, it must be repaired. You can also keep the cords loose and use cord holders or socket sleeves for added security.

Why is my HP laptop not charging?

As I understand you are having issues with the charging light does not light up when plugged in, and you are having issues with the keyboard is not responsive. This definitely looks like a possible hardware failure. I would then suggest you to contact HP phone support to create a service for your Notebook.

Why does my MagSafe light not light up?

The "charger" is inside the computer. That's what's controlling the light on the MagSafe head, although if it doesn't light up there's a chance that the LED is malfunctioning or that the adapter has an issue. Do you have another power adapter? I've got two, so I'm equipped to rule out a bad adapter if I had a problem similar to yours.

Why is my coconut battery charging so slow?

Also, charge becomes slow if you have multiple USB ports plugged in to the same device the slower the charge is. The system report and coconut battery say that it is not charging, however, it is charging extremely slow still. Sounds like you can rule out a bad MagSafe adapter since you tried using another one.

Why does the led on the adapter turn off?

If the LED on the adapter turns off on plugging in the DC cable, there's a short in the system. Try another adapter first - if it does not solve the problem, replace the DC jack:

So the laptop has an internal component that manages the power. It charges the battery, stops charging the battery when out is fully charged, and switches power from the cord to the battery when you disconnect the cord. It's kind of like a traffic light for electricity. This component is integrated into the motherboard.

After 3 minutes, put the battery in its place, plug in the power cord and restart the computer to check if the issue persists. Method 2. A simple way to check the integrity of the battery is to remove it entirely and plug in the power cable to the laptop. If the laptop powers on properly, the problem is likely with the battery.

First thing to do is a hard reboot. Remove the battery and unplug the AC adapter. Then, press and hold the power button for 20 seconds. After that, try booting it up again with the battery and charger. Next test to try would be to remove the battery again and connect just the AC adapter. Then, see if it will boot up or not.

I've tried holding down the power button & Beats button together for 16.seconds and power/more buttons for 15 seconds, both plugged in and unplugged. All to no avail.
