

Why don't you install solar power on the roof

Do I need a roof to get solar panels?

Before you get solar panels, you'll want to know whether your roof is ready and able to support them. Thankfully, most residential roofs in the UK are strong enough and pitched at a decent enough angle - and most other obstacles can be navigated.

How many solar panels can be installed on a roof?

Your roof will need to be large enough to fit a suitable number of solar panels, as there's rarely much point putting just two or three panels up there. The average solar panel takes up 2m², and your installer should leave around 40cm on each side of the array, as well as 3cm between every panel.

Can solar panels work on a flat roof?

Yes, solar panels can work just as well on a flat roof as on a pitched roof, provided they are correctly angled to capture the maximum amount of sunlight. A good racking system can tilt the panels to the optimal angle, ensuring they receive sufficient sunlight throughout the day, which maximises their efficiency.

Do you need planning permission to install solar panels on a flat roof?

Thanks to recent changes to permitted development rules, most installations on flat roofs won't need solar panel planning permission. So long as the panels aren't visible from the street and don't exceed 200mm above the roof, they should be covered under permitted development rights.

Can you install rooftop solar panels if you have a loft space?

It's much easier to get rooftop solar panels installed if you have a loft space. This way, installers can look at the underside of your roof beforehand to check its structure and pinpoint where the rafters are, then look afterwards to make sure the felt isn't torn and the bolts have gone straight into the rafters.
